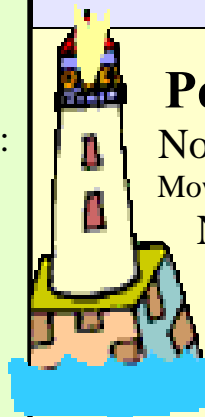

In Feb. 2009 I went to a bike camp in Denia, Spain. Each morning on our way out of town our peloton rode around numerous roundabouts of various shapes, sizes and designs.

At the time we were making plans to rebuild the main road, and debating whether to include a guard shack and gate at some point along our entrance. I hated the idea because of the time and expense it would require to staff the gate and administer passcards for everyone. And it had little security value, since we are exposed on all sides and especially the lakefront.

When I came home, I called Larry Harris, our landscape designer, and asked his opinion of using a roundabout instead. He slowly bought into the idea, and the resulting design was constructed that summer. It accomplished several goals, chief among them getting folks to slow down as they approach the park.

Another goal - that of enhancing the beauty of our entrance - is finally underway! The artwork being unveiled on Saturday was key to the landscape design. I'll tell you more about the sculpture then, but I'm sure you will see how Larry's design creates a fitting and serene setting for the piece.

So for those of you who find our little roundabout inconvenient, consider that it could be worse; there could be a gate! I hope and pray that each person who enters thru the roundabout finds inspiration, encouragement and peace in it's gentle message, "Final Approach."

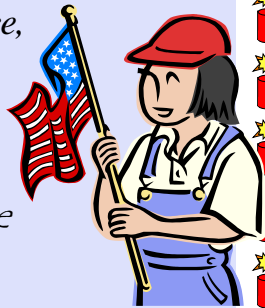
