## Think Safety this Summer

Ahhh... The first holiday weekend of summer. Fishing gear: check. Boat & dock: check. Campfire and s'more supplies: check. We're ready for summer activities.

But are you prepared with these? Sunscreen. Mosquito and tic repellent. First aid kit (how old is it?). Fire extinguisher (has it been checked?). Emergency weather supplies (see checklist pg. 3). Life jackets in the right size. Proper insurance coverage on all your "toys."

Notice the new road signs at Silver Street? We're trying to improve safety at this busy intersection, and we paid the county to install new signs. Its not pretty, but safer we hope.

Here are a few other reminders in the safety category:

- ◆ **Do not obstruct traffic:** Pull off side of road & keep a clear path for vehicles coming & going.
- ◆ **CALL MISS DIGG and Phil** before digging!
- ◆ **Supervise children** whenever they are in clubhouse, using lawn mower, swimming; on the playground, etc.
- ◆ **Golf carts** must have a licensed driver 21 years old or older seated beside any unlicensed driver.
- ◆ **Respect the rules of the road:** one-way street, traffic circle direction, stop signs, speed limit 10, etc.
- ◆ **Use the Buddy system:** avoid doing strenuous activities alone! Partner to launch boats, put in docks, or work out in the exercise room.
- ◆ **Be prepared:** keep flashlight, emergency radio, drinking water supply, medications, blanket, & rain coat. Check smoke & CO<sub>2</sub> detectors.
- ◆ **Golf Carts: Do not overload your cart...**
- ◆ **Walkers: Please use the Sidewalks...**
