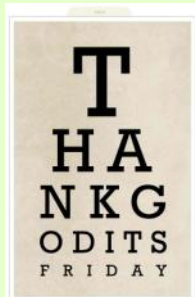

Newspaper Recycling is only for newspapers in brown paper bags. No plastic bags, no cardboard, no magazines, no batteries. Remove Shoppers from the plastic sleeve please!!!!

Compost pile is for yard waste, leaves, & grass clippings only. **Remove all plastic containers, bags, hangers, etc.** No sticks, brush, or woody material.

Cardboard Recycling: Break it down. No Styrofoam and no plastic bags!!!

Brush Pile is for **brush, sticks, & limbs**. No construction materials, furniture, etc.

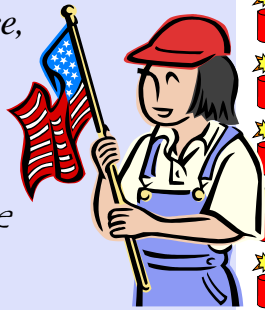
