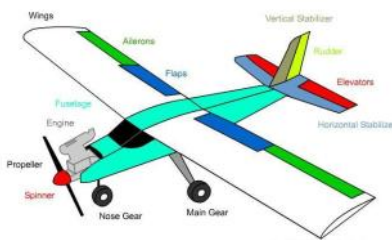

Remote Control Airfield Dedication Planned for June 22

Join us at the picnic potluck on Thur, June 22 to celebrate the dedication of the RC Airfield. After potluck - weather permitting - everyone is invited to the water tower field for a flying demonstration by our local RC plane hobbyists.

The water tower field has been used to fly RC planes for a number of years, and has attracted a growing number of residents to this fun hobby. Fliers benefit from the advice and experience of others, and often help each other find supplies and make repairs.



This year we are improving the landing strip and keeping the grass better maintained for take-off and landing. Please **avoid driving golf carts over the landing strip, and do not drive across field when planes are in use** (stay near trees).

NOTICE TO OPERATORS:

RC planes require instruction, practice and skill to operate and pose potential risks to operators and bystanders. **We ask that anyone operating RC planes or drones from Resort property carry appropriate liability insurance** for any accidental damages to neighboring buildings, vehicles, equipment or persons. One way to obtain this insurance is to become a member of the Academy of Model Aeronautics. We also ask that operators observe the “Academy of Model Aeronautics National Model Aircraft Safety Code,” printed on the back of the AMA membership application.
