Cold Weather Reminders



Seasonal water supplies are being winterized. If you find the water is shut off, please <u>do not turn it back on</u>. If you open one by accident, call the office so we can re-winterize.

Other things to check:

- Seasonal residents: Is your home scheduled for winterizing? If you or someone else winterized your unit, did you tell the office?
- Critter Check! Secure skirting and fill gaps around home & sheds. Please do not feed strays!
- Is your **heat tape** plugged in and operating?
- Is your water filter protected by heat tape & insulation? Do you have hose faucets that need to be shut off and drained?
- Have you **disconnected hoses** from faucets on your home so they can drain? (Backflow preventers can hold water in the line that can freeze)
- Is the **water supply crock** under your home <u>covered</u> with a layer of insulation <u>on top</u>?
- Are your **winter emergency supplies** ready to go? Did you change your smoke alarm battery?

food, breathtaking scenery, and - best of all - lots of time with Andy and his family. We were blessed.




