The Celebrations Singers kicked off our season with a Red White & Blue theme on May 27. What a great night!

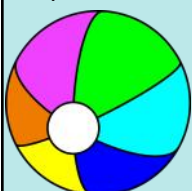

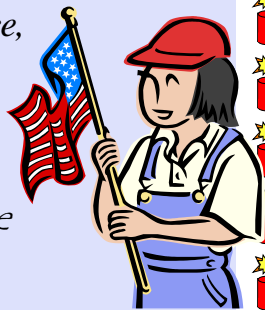

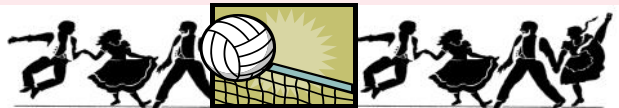
