Recycling Reminders

Waste Management has announced new fees for customers failing to follow recycling rules. "Contaminated" loads may be charged \$69 per yard in addition to the regular container fee. For our 6 yard container that's an extra \$414 per load! Only you can help us avoid these fees!

Recycling DO's:

- * **Do recycle** clean & empty bottles, cans, jars, and dairy/juice boxes.
- * **Do flatten boxes** and remove all bags, foam, and packing materials.
- * **Do check for recycling symbol 1, 2 or 5** on plastic containers. Plastic that does not have one of these symbols should go in the trash. (No flower pots.)
- * **Do keep it clean.** Rinse cans and bottles. Remove all food waste. No peanut butter! No soiled pizza boxes. No aerosol cans. No liquids. Food waste attracts pests!
- * **Do keep plastic bags out of recycling.** (Plastic bags can be returned to local grocery stores for disposal.)



Recycling DON'Ts:

- * **Don't throw in the bag.** Dump recycling loose so it can be inspected. No films, plastic wraps, strapping materials, packing peanuts, etc.
- * **Don't add sharp or dangerous materials.** No needles, no electronics, no plate glass or mirrors, no batteries.
- * **Don't toss in "tanglers."** No hoses, wire, rope, straps, holiday lights, extension cords, hangers, etc.
- * **Don't include bulky items:** No construction materials. No propane tanks. No paint or oil cans. No Styrofoam. No plastic furniture. No tires. No scrap metal.
- * **Don't include** textiles, bedding, rugs or carpets.
- * **Don't include** paper napkins, plates, cups, or tissues. No polystyrene foam (take home boxes).
- * **Don't put hazardous waste in any trash or recycling container.** It is your responsibility to take these materials to a hazardous waste collection center. The resort cannot do this for you. (Oils, chemicals, poisons, etc.)
- * **Don't use recycling unless you can follow these rules!** If in doubt, throw it out - just put it in the regular trash. (unless it is a hazardous waste).
