Water Tower Project Begins in April

Believe it or not, it's already time to make improvements to our water tower. Following the last inspection in 2016, the engineers made several recommendations to maintain and extend the life of the tank. Recommended repairs include:

- Installing cathodic protection inside the tank.
- Adding handholds, a painters rail, and an interior ladder.
- Replacing a faulty mud valve, re-taping insulation.
- Foundation grout & paint.
- Power wash, spot clean and paint exterior of tank.
- New logo! (See photo right.)



The project was placed for bid in December, and the low bid has been awarded to LC United Painting from Sterling Heights. The contract specifies work be substantially completed before Memorial Day, to allow the tank to be back in service in time for summer. Dixon Engineering will supervise the work.

Since the tank will be off-line this spring, watering restrictions will be in place while we operate using the back-up bladder tanks. We will share more information as we have it. Please be prepared to limit lawn and garden watering during the project. **Automatic sprinklers may not be placed in service until the tower is back on line.**

- **Open Home Request:** Return form at least 2 weeks prior to arrival if you want us to open your home.
- **New rate sheets:** Blue sheet for manufactured homes, green for park models/ RV's.

In addition, you may need to follow up on these items:
