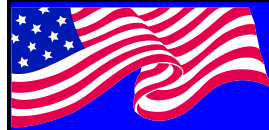

Spring has sprung, and we're off to a busy start. Here are

some of the projects we're working on now:

- **Winter Clean-Up:** Record high water and a late spring have made work difficult for Mark & crew. Please be patient as we work to restore things to good order. **Marina boat slips** are being worked on now. Please wait until they are leveled before use.
- **Golf cart path improvements:** We've added concrete drives to three sections of path. Be careful while we finish filling and seeding these areas. Please keep noise levels down when passing near homes.
- **Beach Safety:** A new sign (see below) with safety reminders, and a new life ring assembly are being installed at the south beach. Due to liability concerns, we will not be using the north swim area this year.
- **Coin Laundry:** Four re-conditioned Maytag top loading coin washing machines will be delivered soon.
- **More trees:** We're replacing seedlings that died after last summer's drought, and we're trying some Canadian Hemlocks in a few places.
- **Party Tent:** We have purchased a new high top tent for the clubhouse picnic area. The old one had to be retired.
- **New Tractor:** Mark's getting his Christmas present early... A new John Deere 4044 compact utility tractor is on its way.
- **Water Tower Improvements:** The crew from LC United Painting is hard at work! Please stay out of their work space and only drive carts on the grass near the tree line when driving to and from the field. **Remember to conserve water until we have tower back on line.**

Security Update: As you may know, we experienced a number of break-ins this spring, and have had reports of property missing from the storage area as well. Welcome to the Beach

Beach Rules

- No glass containers
- No alcohol
- No diving or roughhousing
- Children age 12 and under must be supervised by a responsible adult
- Do not swim alone
- Swim only within marked area
- No nudity
- Do not feed wildlife
- No fishing or boating

NOTICE: Swim at your own risk! Beach is NOT tested for water quality.

Water quality can change hourly.
Before swimming ask these questions:

1. Has there been heavy rain or high winds in the last 24 to 48 hours? Are large numbers of waterfowl present? *If so, bacteria & contaminant levels may be higher.*
2. Does the water look like spilled paint, have scums, mats, films, or are green globs floating below surface? *If so, do not enter the water. Blue-green algae blooms may be toxic!*
3. Will children be playing near the water's edge? *Bacteria levels tend to be higher in shallow water & wet sand.*
4. Does everyone know not to swallow the water? *Never drink lake water, no matter how clear. Wash your hands before handling food.*

Sunday Services

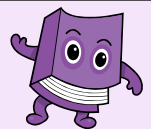


Non-denominational Christian services are held every other week beginning May 27. Services start at 6:30 pm outside, weather permitting. Bring lawn chairs and finger food to share after.

Water Tower Project Underway

Work on the Resort Tower began in earnest the week of April 23. LC United Painting, based in Sterling Heights, was awarded the contract earlier this year. Work includes the following:

- Steel work: Add a painters railing, hand holds and wet interior ladder.
- Install cathodic protection.
- Replace mud valve
- Re-tape insulation.
- Exterior prep & paint, new logo.

The water tower was emptied on April 24 to allow painting of the main tank. Tentative completion date is mid-May, weather permitting. Water restrictions are in effect until done.

Election May 8: St. Joseph County Emergency Management is requesting a 1 mil increase. For info come to Rush Day!

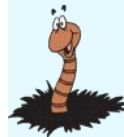

Specific Tax on RV's: Valid license plates must be displayed on the back of your RV to be exempt from \$3/month specific tax. See office for details.

Tornado Drill: If you come to the clubhouse during a warning, please remember the following:

- **Do not block street or sidewalks!** You may double park but always leave a path for emergency personnel.
- **Use lower doors** and lower parking area if possible.
- **Pets are restricted** to the outer basement room. Please keep them in arms or on a very short leash.
- **Do not depend solely on the siren.** Use a weather alert radio, cell phone app, or other device to stay informed.
- **Help your neighbors:** If you know of someone close by who needs assistance, pre-plan how you can help.
