## Mini-storage Building Coming This Spring

The Resort has contracted Morton Buildings to construct a new storage building. The structure will include a large space for resort equipment storage, ringed by 19 ministorage units.

The building will be located directly behind the shop building in the south storage area, starting where the propane tank used to be. If you have boats stored along the east fence line in south storage we will be moving them to allow for construction. Ministorage units will be accessed from outside the fenced area on the north and east sides of the new building, except for the 3 larger bays that face inside the fenced space.

Rental units vary in size and each will have a rollup door. Seven 6x12's, six 10x12's, three 12x12's and three large 12x30 units are planned. The larger bays will have 10 ft. high rollup doors and a 12 ft. ceiling. The resort will have four overhead doors opening into a single 30x60 space inside.

We expect to break ground in early spring and have units ready in time for summer. Rates will be listed on the new rate sheet in March. Please call the office to be added to the waiting list if you are interested.

### Snowplow Reminders

- \* Pleasant Ridge, S. Center, Hammond Dr: Park on one side when >2" snow is forecast. Don't switch sides until snow stops and we have cleared the first side.
- \* No overnight parking on Cherry Oak, N. Center, clubhouse parking or service alley. No overnight parking on grass.

## Resort Water is PFAS Free

In the wake of problems recently found in Parchment, Richland and other parts of Michigan, we were relieved to receive a **test result of 'ND' (not detected) for the Resort drinking water supply.** Testing was performed by the Michigan Dept. of Environmental Quality and results were received in early December.

"Perfluoroalkyl & polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), such as perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS), are part of a group of chemicals used globally during the past century in manufacturing, firefighting and thousands of common household and other consumer products. In recent years, experts have become increasingly concerned by the potential effects of high concentrations of PFAS on human health."
