We'll be talking about this winter for years to come! As many local communities deal with frozen water supplies, the Resort has experienced its first frozen sewer main ever! Rest assured the lake will thaw (not too quickly, we hope), the snowbirds will return, and we'll soon be enjoying a great Michigan summer!

Thank you to everyone who has cooperated and pitched in to help. Mark has put in long hours on the plow, as neighbors coordinate moving their vehicles side to side. Don and many others have helped out with shovels and snow blowers, and Dick and his helpers have shoveled many a roof. You may be tired of it all, but your attitude and helpful spirits really make this place shine!

This year our focus is "taking care of business." We have equipment to maintain, a well to replace, and a wastewater lagoon project to finish. The water tower is due for 5 year inspection, the wastewater permit is up for renewal. We'll be replacing more street lights with LED fixtures, including the "blinking" lights on the entry road. We'll start replacing electric meters in the campground and complying with new regulations from the Public Service Commission. After this hard winter we expect more than the usual grounds cleanup and repairs. Nothing too exciting, but all work we must do to take care of business.





