## Storage Area Reminders

Labor Day brings lots of activity to the storage lot, and each year we have a few problems. Help us out; follow these rules:

1. **Use only your assigned spot.** Only the office can assign a spot! No swapping, trading, etc.
2. If you are unsure of your number, call the office!
3. Back squarely into space, **centering boat on #.**
4. Don't overload your space. 8' wide limit please!
5. Never take blocks or other materials from another empty site.
6. We reserve the right to move improperly parked units and to impound units parked in someone else's spot.
7. If someone is in your spot, report it but **don't take another's spot.** Park in office lot until we can sort things out.
8. **Share the pontoon trailer!** 1 hour limit weekends.
9. Use pontoon trailer with care, and report any problems. **Trailer may not leave the resort at any time!**
10. Annual storage lot fees will be billed in October.

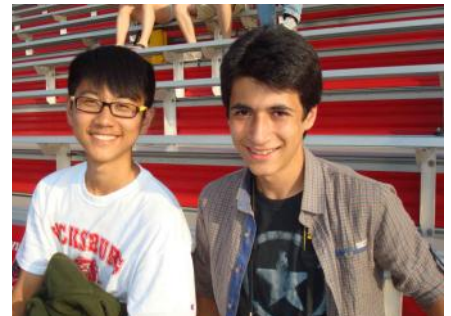

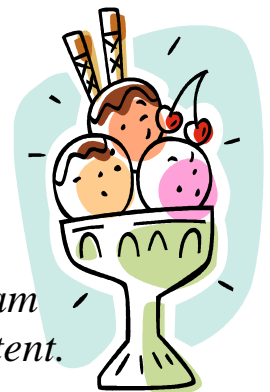

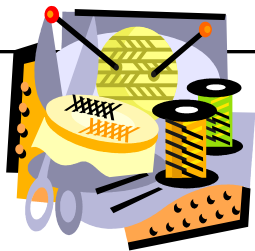
