## Free Services for SEMCO Gas Customers:

### Semco Lunch & EWR Program Nov. 3

SEMCO natural gas customers are invited to a free lunch and to learn about saving energy with their free "Energy Waste Reduction (EWR) Program."

A boxed lunch will be available between 11 am and 1 pm on Wednesday, Nov. 3 in the CB dining room. Representatives will be available to explain the EWR program and invite your participation. (Lunch is optional - you are welcome to come for just the program).

Their goal is to encourage every resident with an active SEMCO natural gas account to participate. The program offers free, professionally installed upgrades valued up to \$600. These upgrades are designed to increase home comfort and reduce energy costs.

The EWR program includes these services:

- Diagnostic tests will determine heat duct leakage and overall home air leakage
- Duct sealing to reduce leakage
- Window & door caulking, gaskets behind outlets and switches.



- Furnace safety test & clean up
- Two carbon monoxide detectors
- Those with gas water heaters are also eligible for hot water pipe wrap, high efficiency shower heads and sink faucet aerators.

The program is OPEN HOUSE style, so you are free to come and go at any time between 11 am and 1 pm. Hope to see you there!

## Cold Weather Reminders

Seasonal water supplies are being winterized. If you find the water shut off, please do not turn it back on!

- Seasonal residents: **Is your home scheduled for winterizing?** If you or someone else will be winterizing your home, did you tell the office?
- **Critter Check!** Secure skirting and fill gaps around home & sheds. Please do not feed strays!
- Is your **heat tape** plugged in and operating? Is pipe insulation secured down to the lower valve in crock?
- Are **hoses disconnected?** **Are unprotected hose lines** drained?
- If you have a **water filter** under your home, is it protected by heat tape & insulation?
- Does your **water supply crock** have a layer of insulation on top? (do not stuff inside crock)
