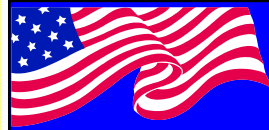

- **Sorry, no pets allowed in clubhouse.** Practice having your pet stay in a secure location in your home.
- **Do not rely solely on the siren.** Use a weather alert radio, cell phone app, or other device.
- **Help your neighbors:** If someone close by needs assistance, pre-plan how you can help.
- **If you are sick or have symptoms,** please wear a mask and isolate in the mechanical room.

Phil's Corner

April's weather has been a roller coaster, but we're working hard to get things ready for what we hope is the return to "normal" this summer. My apologies for the delay in getting out the calendar. The Carers and Sharers will meet soon and - along with Rush Day - we'll be filling in the blanks. Stay tuned! We'll post updates as we receive details.

Attached are the 2022 rule updates. I would like to highlight several:



1. **Pets are not allowed in the clubhouse.** This includes tornado warnings and other emergencies. There simply isn't enough space to safely include your pets. You should have an alternative plan, and practice this plan with your pets. Use the monthly siren tests to teach your pet to go to a place of safety in your home, such as a closet or a pet crate under the bed. With practice they will learn to associate hearing the siren with this routine.

2. **The Resort is a drug-free community.** Michigan's recreational marijuana law specifically allows landlords to prohibit the growing and smoking of marijuana on their property. **Klines Resort does not allow the growing, smoking or vaping of recreational marijuana** anywhere on resort property.



3. **Mailboxes** are now the responsibility of each homeowner. The resort will maintain the stand and the paper tube, but the mailbox is yours to repair or replace. (Yes, we are still installing the new boxes on N. Beach Loop.) Boxes must be black and USPS certified.

4. **Boat shrink wrap may not be placed in dumpsters.** Return wrap to your shrink wrap supplier, or **purchase a recycling bag** from the office. The trailer beside the gate is **only** for wrap placed inside these pre-paid recycling bags.
5. **Guest parking is for guests.** Residents may not park vehicles overnight in guest or overflow spaces. If your vehicles don't fit, please get a space in the storage lot or inquire at office.

Annual Notice Regarding Davis Drive

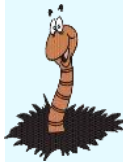

No golf carts, skateboards, bikes, etc are allowed on courts.

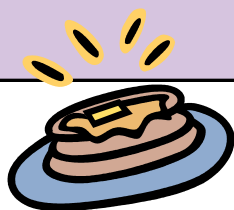


Clubhouse deck, steps & tent pad are for pedestrian use only. No golf carts where marked.
