
Phil's Corner Think Safety!

Ah summer... Fun Fun! But nothing ruins the fun more quickly than an accident or injury. As the park returns to summer busy-ness, we all must do our part to keep everyone safe. You know what I'm going to say, but I'll say it again.

- Golf Carts: (see pg 4) An adult MUST be seated BESIDE an unlicensed or underage driver. Instruct guests on rules before letting them drive.
- Playground & Beach: Children under age 12 must be supervised. Do not allow roughhousing!
- Clubhouse: Minors under age 18 must be with a responsible adult at all times. No one under age 16 may use exercise equipment.
- Dogs must be on a tended leash when outside, with a responsible person on the other end! The owner is responsible to keep dog under their control, with no vicious behavior or threatening/annoying barking.
- Roads are for vehicles: Children should not play in the street. Pull to the side when stopping to talk. Use sidewalks where available.
- **Maintain Access for Emergency Vehicles:** Parked vehicles & golf carts must not obstruct traffic. Keep the middle blue space in front of clubhouse open. Keep path to beach & playground at lots 12-13 open. Don't crowd Lakeshore Dr.; park off the side of the pavement on the lake side.
- 10 MPH.... It's easy! Take your foot off the pedal and ride the break instead.

- Don't depend on just the sirens they may fail or be hard to hear.
- When storms are forecast, stay tuned to TV or radio.
- Set up alerts using a cell phone weather app.
- Be prepared with a cell phone, flashlight, emergency phone #'s, medical info/ prescription, etc.
- If you need assistance, make arrangements with a neighbor to help you move to the clubhouse.
- Stay away from windows, doors, trees, wires.
- Clubhouse will be opened in case of severe weather. Park in lower lot first, enter from basement door.
- Do not block street in front of clubhouse. Volunteers will be there to direct and assist.



GOLF CART RULES

Anyone operating a golf cart at Klines Resort must demonstrate safe driving, with the emphasis on safety



Use of golf carts at Klines Resort is subject to the following requirements:

- RESIDENT IS RESPONSIBLE: Resort resident assumes full responsibility for cart's operation & maintenance, for communication of rules and supervision of any operators, and for damages to property or person resulting from its use.
- **INSURANCE IS REQUIRED:** Proof of liability and hazard insurance is required to use a golf cart at Klines Resort. Submit proof of insurance to obtain sticker for golf cart from office.
- LICENSED DRIVERS ONLY: When driving anywhere on resort property, golf carts must be operated by a licensed driver age 16 or older, except as follows:
 - A responsible adult age 21 or older must be seated directly beside an unlicensed driver.
 - Responsible adult must have ability to take physical control of the cart's steering wheel and brakes if needed.
 - Responsible adult must actively instruct and supervise driver. They should not be holding a child or dog, or be otherwise restricted from assisting driver if needed.
- SAFE OPERATION: Observe all traffic signs and follow rules of the road. Occupants must be properly seated with feet, arms and legs inside the cart. Do not overload cart. Passengers may not sit in the lap of the driver. No joy-riding, erratic swerving, etc. Yield to pedestrians on trails and paths. Do not obstruct traffic by slowing or stopping in roadway.
- **BATTERY POWERED ONLY:** Gas & propane carts are not allowed.
- TIRES: Golf carts must have smooth-ribbed turf tires. Carts with mud/snow/dirt or other knobby or treaded tires must keep off trails, paths and lawns.
- NO "SOUPED-UP" GOLF CARTS: Golf carts able to run at speeds greater the 15 mph, or as allterrain & sport type vehicles, are not allowed on Resort roads, trails, or grounds. (They may be properly stored here for use elsewhere, but not for use here.) Programable carts and carts with governors must be set at no more than 15 mph limit.

- NO DIRT BIKES, 4-WHEELERS, MOPEDS, ORV'S, GO-CARTS, ETC. ALLOWED: They may not be operated on roads, paths, trails or open fields at the Resort. (They may be properly stored for use elsewhere. If needed for ice fishing access, please contact office to request an exception.)
- LOT NUMBERS must be clearly visible on the left rear side of cart.
- LIGHTS REQUIRED AFTER DARK: If operated after dusk, golf carts must have front and rear lights and must remain on paved streets only.
- NIGHT OPERATION: Fields, trails, woods & lakefront are closed to motorized vehicles after dark, except to access boat docks or if used by night watch volunteers.
- PARKING: Carts may not be parked on front yards or sidewalks overnight. Where available, carts should be parked in a storage building, behind home, or on private driveway. If parked on street, cart may not protrude into traffic lane.
- **PROTECT LAWNS:** Where possible, golf carts should remain on established roads and trails. If driven on lawns, care must be taken to avoid ruts and damage to turf. Use caution on lakefront, during spring thaw, and after heavy rains or high water levels. Rutted yards must be repaired.
- **PROHIBITED AREAS:** Golf carts may not be driven in the following areas:
 - Hill on both sides of clubhouse
 - Playground and swimming area.
 - Private lots (Do not drive across another person's yard without permission)
 - Davis Drive (unless authorized user)
 - Crop land (field south of red barn)
 - Sidewalks at marina seawall & in front of clubhouse deck.
 - Sports courts: shuffleboard, tennis, basket-ball, pickleball.
 - NOTE: Do not drive across water tower field when RC Aircraft are being flown.
- NO GUEST EQUIPMENT: Only residentowned equipment may be operated at the resort. Family and friends of residents, short term campers, and others may not bring a golf cart to the park unless special permission is granted and proof of insurance provided.
- **SUSPENSION:** Use of golf carts is a privilege that may be revoked or suspended by resort management if they determine anyone is using cart in a reckless manner or in violation of the rules.
