DOCK OWNERS: Protect our shores:

- Stack dock and posts neatly in a <u>single pile</u>.
- Raise docks & other materials off the ground at least 8 inches (use a standard cement block)



- Stay 10 ft away from the high water line. The waters will rise!
- <u>Store paddleboats, canoes, small</u> boats, etc. in storage area. Do not leave on lakeshore.
- <u>Remove</u> & store all storage boxes, furniture, etc.
- Make sure <u>docks</u> & boat <u>lifts</u> do not obstruct access to neighboring docks.
- <u>No tarps</u>. Be considerate we have to look at your stuff all winter.

We reserve the right to re-stack or remove improperly stored items from the lakeshore. You may be billed the cost of any labor and storage fees this incurs.

Fall Leaf Pickup



Pickup crew begins <u>after Oct 23</u>.

Until then, if you pick up leaves, take to compost area OR <u>bag</u> for pickup.

Curbside pickup of <u>bagged</u> leaves is on Mon & Thurs mornings.

PLEASE: Don't pile leaves in street or gutters where they get wet & clog drains.

Prepare your yard for leaf pickup:

- Store hoses, lawn ornaments, fire pits, and other obstacles. They can ruin equipment.
- Clear off open porches, steps & decks.
- If unable to remove an obstacle from yard, flag it so it can be seen if covered by leaves.
