### DOCK OWNERS: Protect our shores:

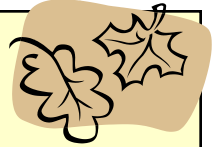
- **Stack dock and posts neatly in a single pile.**
- **Raise docks & other materials off the ground at least 8 inches** (use a standard cement block)
- **Stay 10 ft away from the high water line.** The waters will rise!
- **Store paddleboats, canoes, small boats, etc. in storage area.** Do not leave on lakeshore.
- **Remove & store all storage boxes, furniture, etc.**
- **Make sure docks & boat lifts do not obstruct access to neighboring docks.**
- **No tarps.** Be considerate - we have to look at your stuff all winter.



We reserve the right to re-stack or remove improperly stored items from the lakeshore. You may be billed the cost of any labor and storage fees this incurs.

## Fall Leaf Pickup

Pickup crew begins after Oct 23.



Until then, if you pick up leaves, take to compost area OR bag for pickup.

Curbside pickup of bagged leaves is on Mon & Thurs mornings.

**PLEASE: Don't pile leaves in street or gutters** where they get wet & clog drains.

Prepare your yard for leaf pickup:

- **Store** hoses, lawn ornaments, fire pits, and other obstacles. They can ruin equipment.
- **Clear off** open porches, steps & decks.
- **If unable to remove an obstacle from yard, flag it** so it can be seen if covered by leaves.
