SNOWPLOW REMINDERS

- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING** allowed at clubhouse, on N. Beach Loop, Cherry Oak, North Center, or on the west alley.
- **If >2" snow is forecast**, everyone should park on the same side of street. On **Pleasant Ridge & South Center**, park on west side. On **Hammond Drive** park on south side.
- **CAUTION:** Plow truck makes frequent stops, turns, & back-ups. Avoid our blind spots & give us lots of room to work!
- **If going away overnight**, **do not leave your vehicle parked on street**. Either move vehicle to storage or leave a key with a neighbor who can move your car.

Jottings...

We discourage yard signs. Please observe these limits:

- One (1) **“FOR SALE”** sign no larger than 12”x18” may be posted on the **inside of a front window** after home has been inspected and approved for resale. No yard signs allowed!
- **Signs advertising** contractors, repair services, special events, churches, bazaars, etc. are limited to max. of **15 days** in yard.
- **Election Signs** should be posted no more than **30 days** before voting begins and be removed immediately after the election. (Note: Next primary election is not until Aug. 2024)
- **Open House signs** may only be posted during the hours of a scheduled open house.
- **Decorative signs** (as part of landscaping or attached to home and painted on wood or metal) and **seasonal displays** are allowed as long as they are attractive and in good condition.
- No “beware of dog,” “keep out,” or signs of a threatening nature (firearms) are allowed.
- If you wish to show your support for police, veterans, LBGT, black lives, etc., please consider using a flag or other decorative element. Signs on wires are not attractive or appropriate.
- **No sign may be placed** where they create a hazard or limit access to utilities. A clear path min. 7 ft. wide must exist from the street to the rear of the lot for emergency access.

NOTE: Statements & newsletters will not be mailed to snowbirds and seasonals this winter. Please make sure the office has an email address for you.

Emergency numbers are listed on back of the directory. Office phone will not be checked, so please reach a live person if you have a water leak or sewer backup.



Cold Weather Reminders

Seasonal water supplies are being winterized. If you find the water shut off, please do not turn it back on!

- **Seasonal residents: Is your home scheduled to be winterized? If you or anyone other than Jergins is winterizing your home, did you tell the office?**
- **Critter Check!** Secure skirting and fill gaps around home, porches & under sheds. A squirrel or racoon can do a lot of damage!
- Is your **heat tape** plugged in and operating? Is pipe insulation in good repair? Is heat tape and insulation wrapped around pipe to the lower valve in the crock?
- Are garden **hoses disconnected? Are unprotected hose lines drained?**
- If you have a **water filter** under your home, is it protected by heat tape & insulation?
- Does your **water supply crock** have a layer of insulation over the top? (do not stuff down inside crock)
