Annual Notice Regarding Davis Drive

"A Court Order was entered in the St. Joseph County Circuit Court which limits the use of Davis Drive to the owners of lots in Summer Haven Subdivision and/or their guests or invitees. Residents of the Resort shall not use Davis Drive for ingress and egress to Klines Resort or for recreational purposes, and may only use Davis Drive if they are guests or invitees or a lot owner in Summer Haven Subdivision."

Davis Dr. is the dirt lane that runs along the Resort's north property line. This notice is an annual requirement of our agreement with several of our Davis Drive neighbors. Please respect their desire for privacy. Should you encounter problems with any of these neighbors, please do not confront them and report the incident to the office.

- Follow directions of volunteers.
- Use lower parking lot first.
- **Do not block street or sidewalks!** Always leave a path for emergency personnel & to allow traffic to pass.



Pet Shelter is available. Please have a pet carrier for your pet. Teach your pet to go into carrier when siren sounds. Pet shelter door is just north of the double doors at bottom of steps. Sorry, pets are not allowed in the basement people shelter area.

- **Do not rely solely on the siren.** Use a weather alert radio, cell phone app, local tv station or other device.
- **Help your neighbors:** Pre-plan who you can help as needed.

No pets, golf carts, skateboards, bikes, etc. allowed on the tennis courts or pickle-ball courts.

Sorry, no pets or golf carts are allowed on playground and beach.

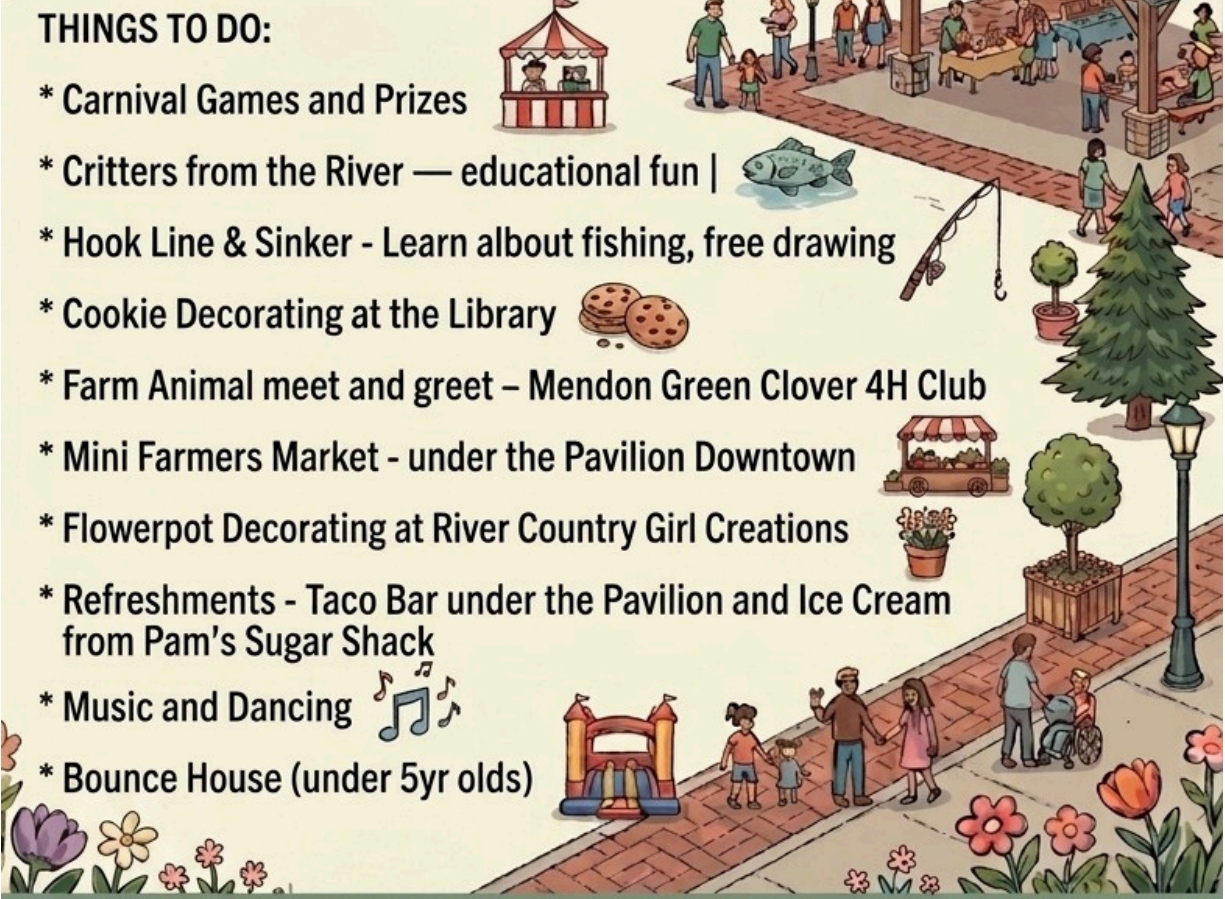
